Student Prerequisites: Prior to being permitted to participate in live fire training evolutions, the student shall have received training to meet the job performance requirements for Fire Fighter I in NFPA 1001. Students participating in the class shall present written evidence of having successfully completed the prescribed training prior to being permitted to participate in any live fire training evolution. Priority will be given to Training Officers and Firefighters responsible for training within their department.
